Leading the Charge: Empowering Our Communities for a Sustainable Delaware

- National and international commitments seek to limit global warming to below 2°C (3.6°F), and preferably to 1.5°C (2.7°F), compared to preindustrial temperatures (defined as the 1850–1900 average).
- To do this, global CO₂ emissions need to reach net zero by ~2050.




Fifth National Climate Assessment

- The U.S. has made progress at reducing greenhouse gas emissions, but current efforts are not sufficient.
- Adaptation efforts have also not kept pace.

Co-benefits are maximized and are aided by partnerships and innovation




Figure 1: Climate Adaptation and Mitigation Synergies
